However, a lot of stairs are now equipped with diagnostic codes to help find the cause of the fault. The Straight Stannah 600 scale is equipped with a user display panel located on the side of the stairs carriage, which allows you to see the status of the staircase and shows the error codes. This is especially useful when you're trying to explain the phone exactly what happened or gone wrong with the elevator. The use of these codes allows the engineer to quickly diagnose the exact cause of the failure or the problem, and in many cases it can be used to solve the problem on the phone. Footrest similar to the armrest footrest also has sensors can stop the lifting of moving. These sensors are directional and are typically located on a bar, plate or spring card surrounding the footrest. These sensors can become blocked or jammed. Each sensor stops the elevator in a specific direction and are indicated as directional sensors. This will allow a chair to move in the opposite direction of an obstacle. For example, if the chair was traveling down to the stairs and the footrest hit an obstacle you would be able to move the lifting back up the stairs.
